OKC Town Hall Lectures were unknown to VillagesOKC members until a few short months

ago. The connection between the two organizations came because VillagesOKC members Gaylene Stiles heard about Town Hall Lectures from a mutual sponsor, Joe Kernke of Smith and Kernke. On her own, Gaylene attended the Lectures during the 2021-2022 season. She was impressed and as a member encouraged VillagesOKC to become a Town Hall sponsor and attend each of the 2022-2023 lectures.

OKC Town Hall brought a wide range of nationally recognized speakers to its 2022-2023 lecture series. They included a military hero, a professor who has written extensively on constitutional law, the author of hundreds of articles ranging from ancient Greece to contemporary culture, a talk show host and bestselling author, and a geopolitical strategist. 




