




From the Director

VillageOKC is credible and solid. With seven Board of Directors and an Advisory Council of 16, bills are paid on time and 990's are completed annually.

Although there have been generous gifts in kind and thousands of volunteer hours to bring us to this point, it takes actual dollars to manage even a nonprofit.


